Sewing machine

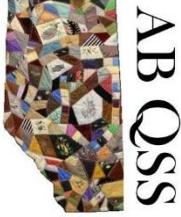
Neutral thread for piecing

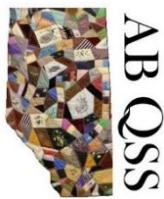
